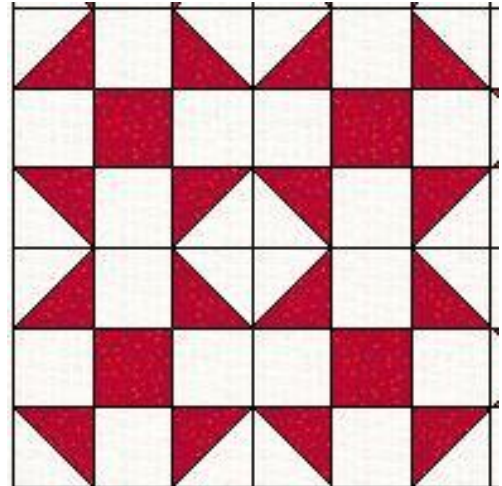

Fabric requirements

1 red fabric, (or color of your choice).
Cream/white for the background

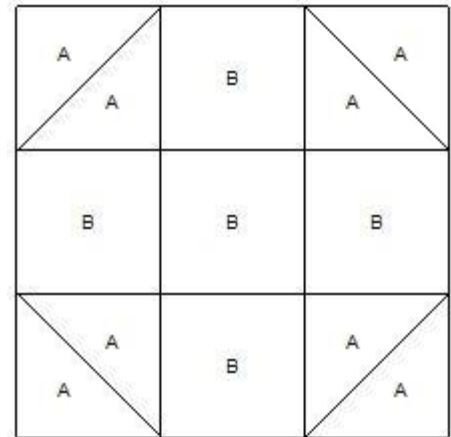
Cut Fabrics

From Cream/white Fabric cut:

8 – 4 1/8" squares
then cut the square in half from corner to corner,
label A.
16 – 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" squares, label B.

From Red #1 cut:

8 - 4 1/8" squares
then cut the square in half from corner to corner.
Label 'A'.
4 – 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" squares, label B



- Starting with the triangles labeled 'A', Sew the 'light' and 'dark' triangle pieces together. Iron.
- Following the diagram above, lay out your block pieces to form the block.
- Sew the pieces of each 'row' together. Iron. Then sew each row together matching up seams. Iron.
- Trim the block up to measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2", (make 4 total).
- Sew the 4 blocks together to make a 4-block square. The finished block measures 20 1/2" x 20 1/2"
