

August - Appliqué Blocks Canning Jar & Iractor

Sample made using various 1930's fabrics Make 1 of each design

Fabric requirements for each block: 1 - 12 ½" x 12 ½" white block

Applique Designs-

heat n bond lite brown thread for appliqué stitch (or thread color of your choice) **Tractor**- red, gold, black and gray fabric **Canning Jar**- gray, blue, red, green






Tractor Block: Following the instructions provided by the fusible web manufacturer, trace 1 set of the tractor pieces grouping together pieces that will be using the same fabric. Cut pieces out. Follow the pattern placement sheet, center on 12 ½" square lining up the center point on the sewing machine placement sheet with the center of square. Remember these blocks are done on point. Iron in place. Using a blanket, zig zag or satin stitch on your sewing machine; sew along the edges of all the pieces. Following the design picture. Practice on some scrap material if you are new to machine appliqué. If you prefer hand stitching you can do a blanket stitch using 2 strands of DMC floss. Using #12 pearl cotton, or two strands of DMC floss, embroider the tractor details using a backstitch.











Canning Jar Block: Following the instructions provided by the fusible web manufacturer, trace 1 set of the canning jar pieces. Cut pieces out. Follow the pattern placement sheet, center on 12 ½" square lining up the center point on the little house placement sheet with the center of the square. Remember these blocks are done on point. Iron in place. Using a blanket, zig zag or satin stitch on your sewing machine; sew along the edges of the appliqué. Practice on some scrap material if you are new to machine appliqué. If you prefer hand stitching you can do a blanket stitch using 2 strands of DMC floss.

Your block is complete! It should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".
