

December's Block

Christmas Present

White or Cream background fabric Green and red 1930's fabric (or color of your choice)



Scant %'' seam throughout unless noted. Block with seam allowance will measure 12 %'' square. (Make 1)

From Cream Background fabric:

Cut 11- 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares

From green fabric:

Cut 3- 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares

From Red fabric:

Cut 8- 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares

- Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on 6 background 3 1/2" squares.
- With right sides together pair cream 3 ½" square and red 3 ½" square. Sew from corner to corner on drawn line. Trim away excess fabric. Press. This forms a triangle square. Make 6 total.
- Following diagram 1. Sew the green, red and white 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to form a nine patch block.



Following diagram 2. Sew the triangle squares and 3 ½" background squares together to form a strip as pictured.



- Following diagram 3. Sew the remaining triangle squares together to form a strip as pictured.
- Sew the block together.
