

Oak Wreath

<u>Supplies</u>

9 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of various fabrics for the background of the block (batik fabrics shown)

6 different batik fabric scraps for the leaves

Heat n Bond Lite or other fusible web material Dark Brown thread for appliqué stitch



<u>Directions</u>: Sew the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make a nine patch block.

Following the instructions provided by the fusible web manufacturer, trace 6 leaves onto the Heat n bond. Iron a leaf onto each of the different batik fabrics for leaves. Cut pieces out. Using the circle as a guide, place on nine patch block forming a wreath, overlapping the leaves. Iron in place. Using a blanket, zig zag or satin stitch on your sewing machine; sew along the edges of all the pieces. Practice on some scrap material if you are new to machine appliqué. If you prefer hand stitching you can do a blanket stitch using 2 strands of DMC floss.
