

The Grinch Mug Rug

By Quilt Doodle Designs

Grinch Mug Rug is an adorable appliqué project. A Really cute mini quilt for your coffee mug and sweet treat!
Finished size 7" x 10"

Supplies:

¼ yard Fusible Web

Invisible & white thread for machine quilting and applique

Scrap fabric in the following colors: yellow, white, red, green

4 black seed beads for eyes and nose

¼ yard blue fabric for front and backing

7" x 10" piece of batting

1/8 yard red for binding



Let's Begin!

Cut 2 7" x 10" rectangles from fabric for backing and Grinch background

Cut 1 7" x 10" batting

From binding fabric:

Cut 1 2" strip the WOF

Following the instructions provided by the fusible web manufacturer, trace 1 set of the Grinch pieces grouping together pieces that will be using the same fabric. Cut pieces out. Follow the pattern placement sheet, place on background fabric. Iron in place.

Layer backing, batting and appliqué top and pin well. Set your sewing machine for free motion quilting and using white thread, stitch around Grinch design as pictured. Use white thread to sew around white hat brim, collar and pom-pom. Sew through all three layers as you stitch. Use invisible thread to stitch down all other pieces. Quilt as desired.

Bind mug rug using 2" strip. Fold in half lengthwise, iron. Sew around edge using a scant ¼" seam. Miter corners.

Sew on seed beads for the Grinch's eyes and nose. Embroider mouth and eyebrows using 2 strands of DMC floss.
